

Parental Permission to Fly Minors Consent Form

This is an important document. Read carefully before signing.

Minor children aged 14 to 18 years may travel internationally alone, including to non-EU destinations. Children under the age of 18 must have their own passport, visa or other international entry documentation required of adults.

In addition, certain countries require children leaving that country without both parents and a legal guardian to have a letter of consent, in some cases notarized. Check with the embassy or consulate in the United States of the destination country for its requirements.

Airlines and travel agents are not responsible for making sure your child has the necessary international travel documents, but they can sometimes provide useful information.
